<u>Selection criteria</u>: TMBA will award such scholarships on the basis of minority race status, financial need, community involvement, commitment to expand diversity and inclusion within the legal profession, and ties to Orange County. Scholarship recipients will be notified by February 05, 2021. **Applicants must be repeat bar takers to apply**

*Previous TMBA bar taker scholarship recipients are not eligible for consideration.

Required documents to attach to this application:

- (1) Applicants must submit a 350- to 750-word essay discussing the following:
 - A personal statement describing your connection, if any, to Orange County and what you will personally do to help expand diversity and inclusion in the legal profession after admission to the State Bar of California.

And

- Self-reflection on your approach to the previous time(s) you took the bar exam, your plan or approach in preparing to take the bar again, and the steps you will take to maintain or increase your level of motivation during your bar preparation period.
- (2) Resume or Curriculum Vitae.
