In order to make this evaluation, the Committee requires (1) a completed Judicial Endorsement Application, (2) a resume, (3) a copy of your Judicial Application; (3) two completed Confidential Questionnaires from your references and (4) an interview with the Judicial Evaluation Committee. The Judicial Endorsement Application and two Confidential Questionnaires (including return envelopes) are enclosed. Please timely distribute the Confidential Questionnaires to your references so the Committee can review the information prior to the interview. No interview will be granted until both Confidential Questionnaires have been returned to the Committee.

We urge you to respond honestly and frankly to the Application and select references who can speak directly to your legal qualifications and anticipated judicial abilities.
